Registration process begins

During the next 10 days, families should expect to receive two important documents in the mail: a student-specific one page letter along with our annual registration packet.

1. Shortly after the July 4th holiday, families will be receiving their student-specific letter with their PowerSchool login information. Please look for this and place in a safe location as you will need it to access your account.
2. You should also receive our annual Registration packet. This includes loads of information about paying fees, how to register your student(s), as well as a wealth of general school information.
3. Please take special note of the important dates listed so you can plan your family calendar around scheduled start up activities for school!

As a Reminder

(IE: Concussion Protocol, the Discipline Code, the Extracurricular Code and the Technology Acceptable Use Policy).

For Freshmen

All Freshmen students must submit proof of a health examination (school physical) in accordance

with Illinois School Code and the Illinois Department of Public Health. At this point, we have no record of a physical for you student. Your student will not be allowed to complete the registration process or attend Freshman Orientation without a completed health examination. Health records from the middle schools do not fulfill the requirements for Freshman registration. Physical forms should be returned to the Health Center at Glenbard South.

For 12th graders

Every student entering 12th grade must show proof of having two doses of meningococcal vaccine. In accordance with District 87 Board Policy, students who don't provide proof of two doses of the vaccine will unfortunately need to be excluded from attending school until proof is given. Please return proof of the meningococcal vaccines to the attention of the Glenbard South Health Center immediately. Please do so to avoid your student being excluded from the first day of school on August 15th. Student who show up to school without record of vaccination on Wednesday, August 15th will be sent home.

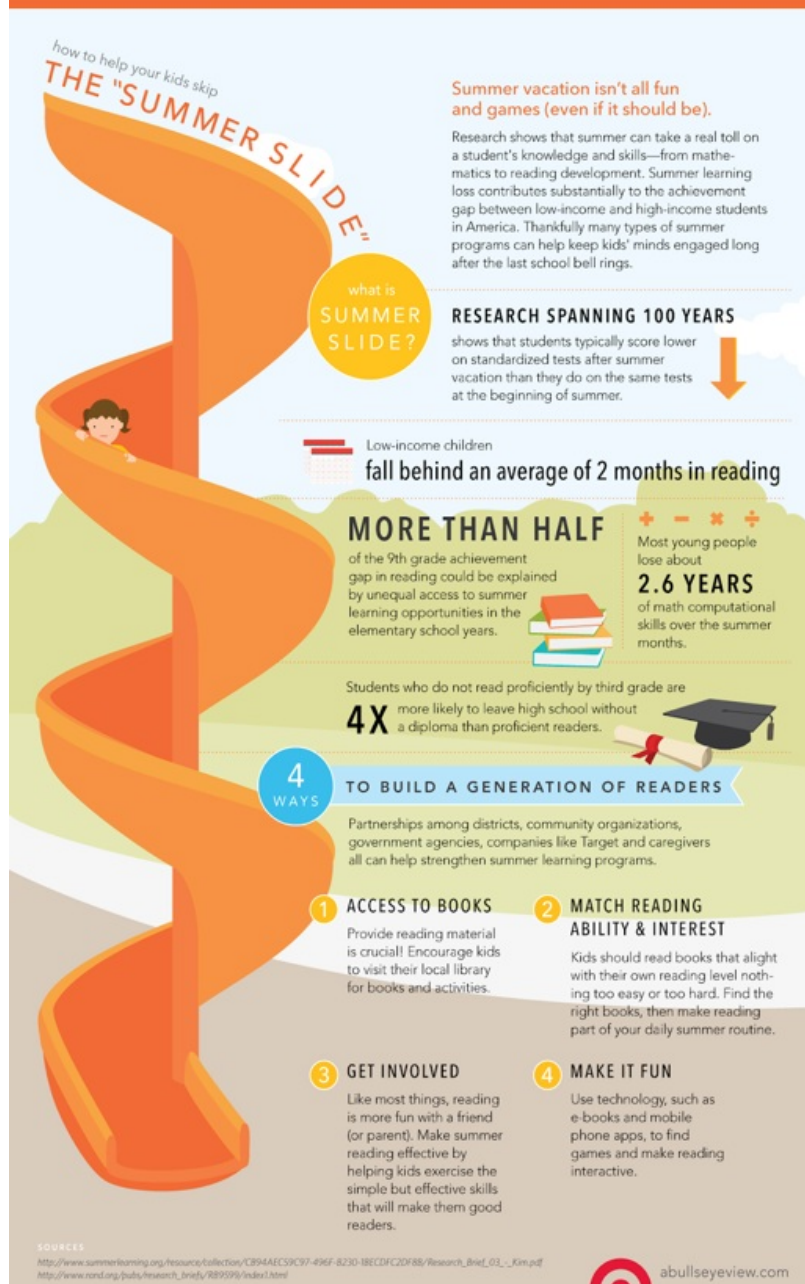
Avoid the Summer Slide

Simply put, "Summer Slide" is the loss of learning that students experience in the summer when they are not actively working their brain and reinforcing what they have learned. There are lots of resources available for parents to help students with avoiding the Summer Slide. A few ideas to help you are listed below:

- All students took part of the SAT suite of assessments last school year. They can log on to their College Board account (or create one - directions linked [here](#)) and link these test scores to a Khan Academy account for personalized computer generated practice.
- Summer School classes are still available. Contact the school if you are interested in signing your student up for a credit-bearing or bridge class to enrich student learning.

State of Illinois Partners with College Board to offer SAT Suite of Tests in 2018-2019

The State recently announced the decision to continue partnering with College Board to offer 9th, 10th, and 11th graders free tests. This is an excellent tool for families, as well as the school, to monitor their progress. You can read the press release on this decision [here](#).

The announcement states "SAT School Day, PSAT 8/9, and PSAT 10 administration will occur April 9, 2019, with a makeup day on April 23. The window for students with accommodations will run from April 9 to 23." More information will be forthcoming in the coming months about Glenbard's plan for standardized testing.

2018-2019 Glenbard South Raider Fall Sport Registration, Tryout and Practice Information

To tryout, a player must present a properly completed IHSA physical exam form (for freshman, a copy/original of the freshman physical form will be accepted), physicals are good for 13 months, have completed the on-line athletic registration through PowerSchool and the one-time \$150.00 athletic fee prior to the first contest. A player will not be allowed to tryout unless the above registration requirements are met. Instructions for how to register for athletics through PowerSchool are included in this packet. Fees can be paid online at the time of registration. Athletic fees may also be included in payment plans, if qualified, and declared at the beginning of the school year. 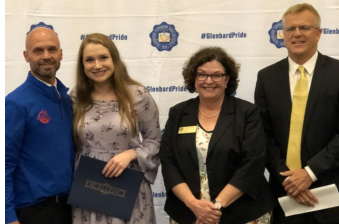

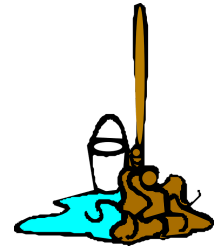

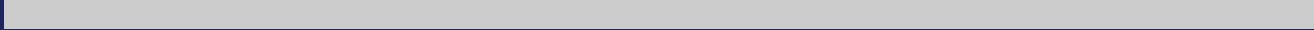
