For Freshmen

All Freshmen must submit proof of a health examination (school physical) in accordance with Illinois School Code and the Illinois Department of Public Health. Health records from the middle schools do not fulfill the requirements for registration. Physical forms should be returned to the Health Center at Glenbard South. Your student will not be allowed to complete the registration process or attend Freshmen Orientation without a completed health examination.

For Seniors

Every student entering 12th grade must show proof of having two doses of the meningococcal vaccine, in accordance with District 87 Board Policy. Please return proof of the meningococcal vaccines to the Glenbard South Health Center, to avoid your student being excluded from the first day of school on August 14. Students who arrive to school without a record of vaccination will be sent home.
