Dear Glenbard South Parent or Guardian:

Welcome to the 2019-2020 school year! We are looking forward to working with your student to make this year successful and rewarding! The information included in this packet will make the process as simple and convenient as possible. As you complete the registration materials in this packet, please keep the following items in mind:

Online Registration & Payment - Online registration will be available July 8th through August 1st Please follow the system prompts to register your student and pay your fees online by August 1st to realize your prompt pay discount of \$35 (Instructions enclosed). Note: If you do not have internet access, computers are available at school during summer hours and your local library has computers available. Registration payments made after August 1st will pay the full registration fee of \$235. Registration and payment of fees are required prior to students receiving instructional materials and schedules during back-to-school week.

Back-To-School Week-Back-to-school week will occur August 5th through August 10th. It is important that students attend on their scheduled day. During back-to-school week, students will receive their class schedules, transportation information, take their ID/yearbook pictures. and receive their iPad, along with training. Freshmen will receive PE uniform/lock during their first week of PE class.

Notification System - Glenbard has implemented a new notification system to improve communication with our families. Please make sure the "Demographic" section is completed as part of the registration process and to ensure we have current contact information.

REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT OF FEES

<u>FEES & REGISTRATION:</u> Glenbard utilizes an on-line registration process for families. Please refer to the enclosed "On-Line Registration" flyer contained in this packet for instructions. Both parent/guardian and student will be required to approve on-line policies and terms/conditions. Glenbard's Student Fee Schedule is located under the Parents section of the website.

The required fees for all Glenbard South students are:

- \$235 Registration Fee (Prompt pay fee of \$200 if paid in full on or before August 1, 2019)
- \$189 iPad Rental Fee (Juniors-Seniors)
- \$149 iPad Rental Fee (Freshmen-Sophomores) as a result of reduced cost from our vendor
- \$85 Digital Curriculum Fee

<u>Deadline</u>: On-line registration and payment must be completed **by Thursday, August 1st**. Registration and payments received after this date will pay the \$235 Registration & Fee charge versus the prompt pay fee of \$200.

Registration & Fees: The Registration and Fees charge includes registration, all course fees, student activity pass and digital handbook.

<u>Supplies - Required</u>: PE uniform and lock will be provided to all <u>incoming freshmen</u> during the first days of school and will be directly billed (\$24) to you for online payment. If needed, returning students will be able to purchase PE uniforms and lock once school is in session.

Optional Fees: The Athletic participation fee is \$150 per student, per year. The fee allows your student to participate in unlimited sports. In addition, yearbooks are available for purchase through the on-line registration & payment process. Students that sign up for the Behind the Wheel portion of Drivers Education, will be charged \$350. Parking passes are limited and the annual fee is \$200.

<u>PAYMENT OF FEES:</u> It is the policy of the Glenbard Board of Education that prior to the first official day of class students are expected to have paid fees and course materials in full. Payments are due by August 1st for families to realize the prompt-pay discount of \$35 and to ensure that your student can participate in Back-to-School Week. The on-line registration process will guide you through the registration and payment process. Families that cannot pay in full due to financial circumstances should refer to the Financial Assistance Programs referenced below.

<u>PAYMENT PLAN:</u> Glenbard offers a 4 pay- payment plan that allows you to pay your fees over the course of the school year. A \$7 convenience fee will apply. <u>IMPORTANT:</u> If you want the optional Athletic Participation Fee to be included in your payment plan, you must select this fee when you register online.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS:

National School Breakfast and Lunch Program - (Free or Reduced Meals): Families that are eligible for the National School Breakfast and Lunch Program (Free or Reduced Meals) must apply each year for approval. Applications for the program can be made via our newly developed on-line application form contained within the Parents section of the website, under Financial Aid - Lunch and Breakfast Program. A link to our PowerSchool system and instructions will be provided at this site. If you believe you are eligible, please complete the on-line application form for submission. If you have questions regarding this program, please contact the Assistant Principal for Student Services Office.

<u>Waiver of School Fees:</u> Families that are eligible for waiver of school fees must apply <u>each</u> year for approval. Applications can be completed during Extended Summer Evening hours through the Office of the Assistant Principal for Student Services. School fee waiver information is contained within the Parents section of the website, under Financial Aid - School Fees. Application forms are available at the school. As part of the waiver application process, you will be required to sign up for the 8-payment plan. This plan will remain in place in the event you are not approved for waiver of fees. **IMPORTANT:** If you want the optional Athletic Participation Fee to be included in your payment plan, you must select this fee when you register online.

Extended Summer Hours: Daytime and evening hours are available this summer to apply for the Fee Waiver and on-line Free or Reduced Breakfast and Lunch programs. Staff will be available from 12pm- 8pm to assist you with the application process on July 29th-July 31st. Please call 630-469-6500 to set up an appointment.

TECHNOLOGY:

<u>All incoming freshmen</u> will be issued an iPad to manage coursework. The annual rental fee for the iPad, case, insurance and loaner program is \$149 per year¹, per student. Freshmen should look for more details on the "Freshmen Back-to-School Day" page of this packet. Freshman and Sophomore students are eligible for this fee due to the reduced cost of the iPad from our vendor.

Returning students that were issued an iPad for the 2018-19 school year are responsible for maintaining their device in good working order and will use their device for the upcoming 2019-20 school year. Returning students are expected to bring their device to Back-to-School Week for an 'iPad readiness' inspection. Students should run all software updates in advance to help expedite this process. Returning juniors and seniors will continue to be billed the \$189¹ per year iPad rental fee.

¹After the family has made 4 annual rental payments over the student's career at Glenbard and the student's account is paid in full, the device will become the property of the student. In other words, this is a rent-to-own program.

<u>Digital Curriculum/App Fee:</u> Students will also be required to pay an \$85 annual digital curriculum/App fee that covers the costs of all digital curriculum (digital textbooks, digital novels, digital workbooks) and applications (Schoology, our learning management system; etc.) that the student will use for their coursework.

Note: Certain courses may still require non-digital materials (hard-bound textbooks; paperback novels or workbooks). If your student is provided these non-digital materials, they will be provided at <u>no additional charge.</u> Textbooks must be returned by the student in good condition at semester end (semester classes) or by year end (year-long classes), or fines could apply.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

<u>ATHLETICS:</u> Athletic registration information is included in this mailing. Athletic participation fees are \$150 per year, per student. Payment of the fee allows your student to participate in <u>unlimited sports</u> for the year. Note: You must register your student for school prior to registering your student for a sport.

BELL SCHEDULES: The schedules can be found in the digital student handbook or viewed on-line at www.glenbardsouthhs.org under the "Students" tab.

BUS TRANSPORTATION:

<u>Providers</u>: Glenbard contracts with **First Student** for regular education transportation services. **Hopewell Inc.** provides transportation services for our special education transportation needs.

<u>Bus Routes</u>: Glenbard uses transportation routing software to lower transportation costs and increase efficiency. Bus routes may be different from one school year to the next as routes are re-evaluated. Please look for bus information at Back-to-School Week in August. Route information for your student will be available at www.glenbardsouthhs.org.

<u>Student ID - Ridership Requirements</u>: Students are required to present upon request their student ID to any bus driver or Glenbard staff member. Students not able to produce their ID will be required to receive a temporary pass to ride the PM bus. Students not able to produce their ID will be referred to the Deans' Office for appropriate consequences. Students will be responsible for riding their designated buses. Bus drivers and school administrators will deny requests for students to ride other routes than previously assigned unless pre-approved by the Deans' office.

<u>GPS Bus Tracking</u>: Glenbard has decided to terminate the First Student <u>FirstView™ Parent App</u> for the 2019-20 school year due to limited use by students & parents, cost and concerns regarding accuracy of information. We will continue to assess this product over time and make a determination regarding reinstatement.

<u>AP EXAM TIMELINE:</u> The College Board has changed its timeline for ordering AP exams for 2019-2020. Specifically, exams will need to be ordered and paid for by November 15, 2019. The fee for each AP Exam remains at \$94 per exam; \$142 for AP Seminar and AP Research exams. Exams ordered late between November 16 and March 13 incur an extra \$40 late fee. More information will be provided from school staff once school commences, however, we wanted to make you aware of this change now.

FOOD SERVICE: District 87 is pleased to partner with Sodexo, Inc. for our cafeteria service. Important information regarding Sodexo, menu offerings, on-line prepayment instructions for student breakfast and lunch is located in Parents section of the web site, under Food Service. We encourage you to visit www.MySchoolBucks.com to sign up for the prepayment option; the system is easy to use & provides parents with management options such as auto-refill, balance review, low balance warning email, and visibility to items purchased by your student. **Students can purchase breakfast and lunch using debit or credit cards.**

INSURANCE: District 87 provides "school-time" accident insurance protection for your student as part of its current insurance program. "School time" includes the school day while your student is attending academic school sessions and up to one hour before and one hour after regular classes. Your student is protected during school-sponsored activities as well, which further includes travel directly or indirectly and uninterruptedly to and from such school activity. Note: This coverage does not include interscholastic tackle football. Benefits are secondary to all other collectible insurance policies. Accidents or injuries must be reported to the appropriate teacher, coach, trainer, or nurse as soon as possible. Accidents that are not reported within 30 days of the accident will not be covered by the insurance carrier. Medical insurance is the responsibility of parents. This insurance program is for "school-time" accidents only. Optional coverage can be purchased for two programs: 24-Hour Optional Coverage and Grade 9-12 Interscholastic Tackle Football. Insurance brochures are available during Back-to-School Week or can be received by calling the school.

MEDICAL REQUIREMENTS (PHYSICALS):

<u>Freshmen Only</u>: All freshmen and transfer students must provide a completed physical with required immunizations to the School Nurse by August 1, 2019. The physical exam must be completed on or after August 1, 2018. IHSA sport physicals do not meet the school entrance requirement. An appointment for a physical **will not** be accepted in place of the physical exam. Students will not be permitted to participate in Back-to-School Week, unless the School Nurse has received the required Health Exam and Immunizations. If you have questions contact MAIN OFFICE NUMBER (630)469-6500.

<u>Seniors Only</u>: All seniors will need to provide proof of receiving the Meningitis Vaccine to the School Nurse by August 1, 2019 Without proof, students will not be permitted to pick up their schedule or start school.

<u>PARENT ORGANIZATIONS</u>: Glenbard South Boosters supports the schools A+ efforts in academics, activities, aesthetics, and the arts, affording students at our community's award winning high school opportunities they would not otherwise have. For more information or to register online, visit us at www.gsboosters.org. A membership form is in this packet.

<u>PARKING PERMITS</u>: Seniors Only – Seniors can apply for a parking permit during Back-to-School Week on August 7, 2019. Application and information will be available on our website starting on August 1st.

<u>PICTURES</u>: Yearbook and ID photos are taken at Back-to-School Week. Students should dress neatly and in good taste. If ordering yearbook pictures, the student must have a separate check with them.

<u>PRINCIPAL'S NEWSLETTER</u> - RAIDER E-NEWS: Raider e-News will be sent electronically to the email address you provide in PowerSchool. This provides information on current events, achievements and other topics relevant to the Glenbard South Community.

RESIDENCY VERIFICATION: All families must verify residency each year prior to registering for school. Residency verification was due June 14. Glenbard has implemented an electronic residency verification process and the majority of our families were electronically verified. However, if we could not electronically verify your residency, you should have received a letter in the mail from us in May, requiring you to verify residency in person or by mail by the due date referenced above. Residency procedures are located in the Parents section of our website, under the Residency Verification section, located at https://www.glenbard87.org/residency-verification-school-boundary-search/. Verification of residency protects all of our families and ensures that only students that live in our school district boundaries attend Glenbard schools. It is illegal to attend school in a

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district where you are not a resident. Contact the Assistant Principal for Student Services (APSS) at school for more information.

STUDENT SCHEDULES: Final schedules will be provided to your student at Back-to-School Week. Counselors will be available on a limited basis for questions beginning August 6th.

<u>TECHNOLOGY CENTER OF DUPAGE (TCD</u>): The first day of class for TCD is August 16, 2019. Student's registered for TCD will begin attending on this day. TCD students will be required to be in attendance at Glenbard South for the full day on August 14-15, unless excused by a Parent or Guardian.

YEARBOOK: Your Glenbard South Yearbook can be purchased as part of the on-line registration and payment process. Please purchase the yearbook at this time to reserve your book! After school is in session you will also be able to reserve your yearbook through the online store available anytime at www.shop.jostens.com.

<u>PARTNERSHIP FOR EDUCATIONAL PROGRESS:</u> Partnership for Educational Progress or PEP is an educational foundation that provides financial resources to enhance student achievement and enrich learning opportunities for Glenbard Township High School District 87 and its feeder districts. PEP provides funding for:

- <u>Educational enrichment:</u> donations used to support curriculum enhancing projects and innovative teaching initiatives that enhance student learning.
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Back-to-School Week for Sophomores, Juniors & Seniors (Freshmen see enclosed information sheet)

Classroom materials for Sophomores, Juniors and Seniors will be provided at no <u>additional cost.</u> If needed, returning students will be able to purchase PE uniforms and lock once school is in session. In addition, students will receive class schedules, locker and bus information, have an iPad readiness inspection and take yearbook & ID photos (the school dress code does apply). Seniors will only take their ID photo since their Yearbook picture is taken at their portrait time.

Students may be accompanied by a parent or an older sibling but this is not required. Please note: If you choose to purchase a photo package, a separate payment will be required.

Extended Summer Hours (Financial Assistance Available)

We have dedicated three days during the afternoon and evening to help families with the following business: Enrollment and lunch/fee waiver applications. These are the ONLY times that school staff will be available to process fee waiver applications. If you plan on taking advantage of these evening hours, the following are some critical pieces of paperwork that you will need to bring. DO NOT MAIL DOCUMENTS. You must meet with appropriate school staff to handle this process.

Residency

You may be asked to prove residency. If requested, you must provide a current lease with proof of most recent payment or tax bill, mortgage documents, along with at least two other proofs of residency (driver's license, gas, or electric bill, voter registration card, automobile registration.)

Enrollment

Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE) transfer form, unofficial transcripts, all test scores, and immunization records.

Students in Special Education must have a copy of their IEP. ELL students may be tested.

Fee Waiver Applications

Recent tax return, W-2 form, and your last two pay stubs (for each family member working). Evidence of participation in AFDC, TANF, or Food Stamp Program must also be presented. Mediplan cards, Link cards, and Illinois Kid Care Insurance cards **will not** be accepted as verification of eligibility.






- Register for athletics before signing up for a payment plan or athletics must be paid in full.
- In payment plan installments are not made by the set due dates, you will be removed from the payment plan and athletic fees will be due in full immediately.
- 1) In PowerSchool, click on **Athletics** from the menu on the left (Athletics) or click on a students name in Step 2 of the Registration Wizard.



- 2) Read and agree to the agreements that appear on screen
- 3) To register a student for athletics select a **Season**, select a **Sport**, and click **Submit**. **Note:** You can select sports from multiple seasons before clicking Submit.



4) You can continue to register additional students for sports, by clicking on their names in step 2 Registration Wizard.



5) After your student(s) have been registered, click **Student Fees** (Student Fees) from the menu on the left side of the page or click the **Click here to pay student fees** link from Step 3 of the Registration Wizard.

Online Registration Through Glenbard

Establish Your Account: Do you already have a Glenbard PowerSchool parent account?

- YES Great, then the entire registration process can be completed with just a few clicks.
- <u>YES, but I have an incoming freshman</u> Simply add a new student to your <u>existing</u> parent account by clicking on the **Add new students** through **Account Preferences** link.

Register & Pay:

- 1. If you received a letter in May to **verify residency** this must be completed before proceeding to PowerSchool. Reference the instructions in the May letter to verify residency. *
- Log in to PowerSchool on or after Monday July 8, 2019, and follow the on-screen instructions. There are help files and video tutorials there to assist you. <u>Both parent/guardian AND student(s) will be required to be present during online registration to individually agree to handbooks, agreements, and terms & conditions.</u>
- 3. **Review** your information and your student's information. **Submit changes** if needed.
- 4. Register for a sport if you wish to pay for it on a payment plan.
- 5. Click on Student Fees to complete the process and make your Registration Payment online. If you would like to pay for athletics on a payment plan, your student must be registered for at least one sport before setting up a payment plan for registration fees. You must register and pay by midnight Thursday August 1st, 2019 to receive the discounted registration fee.
