Dear Glenbard South Parent/Guardian,

Welcome Raiders to the 2021-2022 school year! Glenbard South is excited to be planning for an eight period, in-person schedule for the upcoming school year. Please pay close attention to the deadlines and important information in this packet. The South staff is working hard to help our students return to a more typical school schedule with needed support in this transition. Our first attendance day for students is August 11, 2021. Please take the time to read the enclosed packet.

**Online Registration & Payment** – Online registration will be available July 1<sup>st</sup> through July 29<sup>th</sup>. Please follow the system prompts to register your student and pay your fees online **by July 29<sup>th</sup>** to realize your prompt pay discount of \$35 (Instructions enclosed). Registration and payment of fees are required prior to the first day of school.

**New Students to Glenbard** – Glenbard utilizes the iPad and digital curriculum/applications to deliver instruction to students. Before Glenbard can ship the iPad and instructions to new students, registration requirements must be completed and all medical and immunization records must be provided to the school nurse. We **strongly encourage you to register as soon as possible** so we can deliver the device and instructions on a timely basis. This will provide your student as much time as possible to become familiar with the device and digital curriculum, prior to the start of school.

**Notification System** – It is extremely important that you complete the **Glenbard Notification Information - Automated** section as part of the registration process to ensure that we have your current contact information. This will ensure you receive important notifications from the school and district office.

**AP Exam Enrollment** - If your student has enrolled in an AP course for the upcoming school year, we will also enroll them for the AP Exam. Glenbard will bill the AP exam fee on your student's fee statement and will waive one AP exam fee per year, per student. The AP exam is \$95 each; AP Seminar & AP Research exams are \$143 each. More information regarding the AP courses and exams can be located on our school's website.

**Food Service** - During the 2021-2022 school year, we will be operating our food service program under the Seamless Summer Option (SSO) as approved by the USDA. This means all students attending Glenbard schools will be eligible for free breakfast and lunch meals daily. Families will not need to complete an application for this program.

### **REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT OF FEES**

**FEES & REGISTRATION:** Glenbard utilizes an on-line registration process for families. Please refer to the enclosed “On-Line Registration” flyer contained in this packet for instructions. Both parent/guardian and student will be required to approve on-line policies and terms/conditions. Glenbard’s Student Fee Schedule is located under the Parents section of the website.

#### **Required Fees:**

- \$235 - Registration & Fees (Prompt pay fee of \$200 if paid in full by July 29) – fee includes registration; all course fees; student activity pass and digital handbook.
- \$149 - iPad Rental Fee<sup>1</sup>
- \$85 - Digital Curriculum Fee

*<sup>1</sup>Fee includes device, charger, case, insurance coverage and loaner program. After the family has made four annual rental payments over the student’s career at Glenbard and the student’s account is paid in full the device will become the property of the student. In other words, this is a rent-to-own program.*

**Deadline:** Families must complete on-line registration and payment by July 29<sup>th</sup>. Registration and payments received after this date will pay the \$235 Registration & Fee charge versus the prompt pay fee of \$200.

**PE Uniform & Lock:** PE uniform and lock will be provided to all incoming freshmen. The PE uniform & lock charge of \$26 will be directly billed to you for on-line payment. If needed, returning students will be able to purchase PE uniforms and lock once school is in session. Note that due to last year’s circumstances, sophomores will receive their uniform and lock at the start of the year as well.

**Advance Placement (AP) Fee Process & One Free Test:** Glenbard charges the AP exam fee through the registration process in the summer, along with the other student fees. The AP exam is \$95 each; AP Seminar & AP Research exams are \$143 each. Our School Board has made the investment to pay for the cost of the first AP exam for every student, so families will only be responsible for paying the AP exam fee for their student’s additional exams each year. Families will have the opportunity to ‘opt out’ of the exam and fee by October 14, 2021 or February 14, 2022 for 2<sup>nd</sup> semester only AP courses. After the dates, families will be responsible for a \$40 unused/canceled exam fee. More information regarding the AP courses and exams can be located in the “Parents” section of our website under “AP Testing”. If you are in need of financial assistance for AP Exam Fees, please contact your building Assistant Principal for Student Services.

**Optional Fees:** The athletic participation fee is \$150 per student, per year. The fee allows your student to participate in unlimited sports. Yearbooks are available for purchase through the on-line registration & payment process. Students that sign up for the Behind the Wheel portion of Drivers Education will be charged \$350. Parking passes are limited and the annual fee is \$200.

**Payment of Fees:** It is the policy of the Glenbard Board of Education that prior to the first official day of class families should pay fees in full. Payments are due by July 29<sup>th</sup> for families to realize the prompt-pay discount of \$35. The on-line registration process will guide you through the registration and payment process. Families that cannot pay in full due to financial circumstances should

refer to the Financial Assistance Programs referenced below.

**Payment Plan:** Glenbard offers a 4-pay, payment plan that allows you to pay your fees over the course of the school year. A \$7 convenience fee will apply. **IMPORTANT:** If you want the optional Athletic Participation Fee to be included in your payment plan, you must select this fee when you register online.

#### **FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS:**

**National School Breakfast and Lunch Program - (Free or Reduced Meals):** During the 2021-2022 school year, Glenbard will be operating the food service program under the Seamless Summer Option (SSO) as approved by the USDA. This means all students attending Glenbard schools will be eligible for free breakfast and lunch meals daily. Families will not need to complete an application for this program.

**Waiver of School Fees:** Families that receive SNAP, TANF or Income Eligible Medicaid should be directly certified for waiver of fees by our business office. Families can also apply for waiver of student fees if they meet the household income eligibility requirements. Families can apply on-line for fee waiver. Information is located within the "Parents" section of the website, under "Financial Aid" then "School Fees". If you apply for a waiver of school fees you must also sign up for Glenbard's 8-payment plan. Please refer to the enclosed "On-Line Registration" flyer contained in this packet for instructions. After you select 'Student Fees', choose the 8 payment option and complete the information. If your waiver is declined, the 8-payment plan will be activated and your fees will be paid over the course of the school year in 8 equal installments. **IMPORTANT:** If you want the optional Athletic Participation Fee to be included in your payment plan, you must select this fee when you register online.

**Extended Summer Hours:** Daytime and evening hours are available this summer for you to receive assistance to apply for the Fee Waiver. Staff will be available from 8 a.m. until 7 p.m. to assist you with the application process on July 27<sup>th</sup> and July 29<sup>th</sup>. Please call **630-469-6500**, after July 1<sup>st</sup> to make an appointment.

#### **TECHNOLOGY & TRAINING:**

##### **iPad, Charger & Case:**

**All incoming freshmen and transfer students** will receive an iPad to manage coursework. Glenbard will ship your iPad and training information to your residence after you have registered, paid your fees and/or signed up for a payment plan. We strongly encourage families to **register as early as possible** so that your student has more time to train on their device prior to the first day of school.

**Returning students** that had an iPad for the 2020-21 school year are responsible for maintaining their device in good working order and will use their device for the upcoming 2021-22 school year. Returning students should run all software updates prior to the first day of school. If you experience technical issues with your iPad contact the technical support help desk at 630-942-7777.

**Digital Curriculum/Applications:** Glenbard provides students with digital curriculum (digital textbooks, digital novels, digital workbooks) and applications (Schoology, our learning management system; etc.) that the student will use for their coursework.

Note: Certain courses may still require non-digital materials (hardbound textbooks; paperback novels or workbooks). If your student needs these non-digital materials, they will be provided at **no additional charge**. Textbooks must be returned by the student in good condition at semester end (semester classes) or by year-end for (full term classes), or fines could apply. These materials will be provided to your student once school is in session.

**BACK-TO-SCHOOL WEEK (BTSW):**

During Back-to-School week, students receive class schedules, student lockers, PE uniforms if needed, and busing information. Yearbook and ID photos are taken at this time; dress code applies. THIS IS THE OPPORTUNITY TO GET YOUR ID, YEARBOOK PICTURE & OFFICIAL SCHEDULE.

**ADDITIONAL INFORMATION**

**ATHLETICS:** Athletic registration information is included in this mailing. Athletic participation fees are \$150 per year, per student. Payment of the fee allows your student to participate in unlimited sports for the year. Note: You must register your student for school prior to registering your student for a sport.

**BELL SCHEDULES:** Your student's bell schedule is located in the digital student handbook or on-line at [www.glenbardsouthhs.org](http://www.glenbardsouthhs.org) under the "Students" tab.

**BUS TRANSPORTATION:**

**Providers:** Glenbard contracts with **First Student** for regular education transportation services. **Hopewell Inc.** provides transportation services for our special education transportation needs.

**Routes:** Glenbard uses transportation routing software to lower transportation costs and increase efficiency. Bus routes may be different from one school year to the next as routes are re-evaluated. Route information for your student will be available on-line, on your school website.

**Student ID - Ridership Requirements:** Students are required to present upon request their student ID to any bus driver or Glenbard staff member. Students not able to produce their ID will be required to receive a temporary pass to ride the PM bus. Students not

able to produce their ID will be referred to the Deans' Office for appropriate consequences. Students will be responsible for riding their designated buses. Bus drivers and school administrators will deny requests for students to ride other routes than previously assigned unless pre-approved by the Deans' office.

**FOOD SERVICE:** District 87 is pleased to partner with Sodexo, Inc. for our cafeteria service. Important information regarding Sodexo, menu offerings, on-line prepayment instructions for student breakfast and lunch is available in the Parents section of the website under "Food Service". We encourage you to visit [www.MySchoolBucks.com](http://www.MySchoolBucks.com) to sign up for the prepayment option. The system is easy to use and provides parents with management options such as auto-refill, balance review, low-balance warning email, and visibility to items purchased by your student.

**Important note:** During the 2021-2022 school year, Glenbard will be operating the food service program under the Seamless Summer Option (SSO) as approved by the USDA. This means all students attending Glenbard schools will be eligible for free breakfast and lunch meals daily. A complete meal as defined by the USDA guidelines will be offered free of charge. A la carte items such as chips, cookies, etc. will be available for purchase. Students will be able to purchase items using cash, MySchoolBucks funds, or debit and credit cards.

**INSURANCE:** District 87 provides "school-time" accident insurance protection for your student as part of its current insurance program. "School time" includes the school day while your student is attending academic school sessions and up to one hour before and one hour after regular classes. Your student is protected during school-sponsored activities as well, which further includes travel directly or indirectly and uninterruptedly to and from such school activity. **Note: This coverage does not include interscholastic tackle football.** Benefits are secondary to all other collectible insurance policies. Accidents or injuries must be reported to the appropriate teacher, coach, trainer, or nurse as soon as possible. Accidents that are not reported within 30 days of the accident will not be covered by the insurance carrier. Medical insurance is the responsibility of parents. This insurance program is for "school-time" accidents only. Optional coverage can be purchased for two programs: 24-Hour Optional Student Accident Coverage and Grade 9-12 Interscholastic Tackle Football. Insurance brochures are available during Back-to-School Week or can be received by calling the school.

#### **MEDICAL REQUIREMENTS (PHYSICALS):**

**Freshmen & Transfer Students Only:** All freshmen and transfer students should provide a completed physical with required immunizations to the school nurse by July 30<sup>th</sup>. The physical exam must have been completed within one year of entrance into 9<sup>th</sup> grade. Students cannot attend 'in person' school unless the school nurse has received the required Health Exam and Immunizations. If you have questions, please call (630) 469-6500.

**SENIORS ONLY:** All seniors will need to provide proof of receiving the Meningitis Vaccine to the School Nurse by July 30<sup>th</sup>. Students cannot attend 'in person' school unless the School Nurse has received this information.

**RAIDER NEWS:** News will be sent electronically to the email address you provide in PowerSchool. This provides information on current events, achievements and other topics relevant to the Glenbard South Community.

**PICTURES:** Student ID photos taken during Back-to-School Week will also be used as your student's yearbook picture. Students should dress following the dress code.

**RESIDENCY VERIFICATION:** All families must verify residency each year prior to registering for school. Residency verification was due June 16<sup>th</sup>. Glenbard verified 90% of our student's residency electronically. If we could not electronically verify your residency, you should have received a letter in the mail from us in May, requiring you to verify residency in person or by mail by the due date referenced above. Residency procedures are located in the Parents section of our website, under the Residency Verification section. Verification of residency protects all of our families and ensures that only students that live in our school district boundaries attend Glenbard schools. **It is illegal to attend school in a district where you are not a resident.** Contact the Assistant Principal for Student

Services (APSS) for more information.

**STUDENT ID REQUIREMENTS:** Students will be required to carry, and present upon request, their student ID to any Glenbard staff member. Student IDs are required for entry to the building, to get on the bus, lunch purchase, library and lab check in, etc.

**STUDENT SCHEDULES:** Final schedules will be available online by August 1<sup>st</sup> in Schoology. Please contact the School Counseling Office with any questions.

**TECHNOLOGY CENTER OF DUPAGE (TCD):** The first day of class for TCD is scheduled for Thursday, August 12<sup>th</sup>. TCD students will be required to be in attendance at Glenbard South for the first attendance day on August 11<sup>th</sup>, unless excused by parent or guardian.

**YEARBOOK:** Your Glenbard South yearbook can be purchased as part of the on-line registration and payment process. Please purchase the yearbook at this time to reserve your book. After school is in session you will also be able to reserve your yearbook through the online store available anytime at [www.shop.iostens.com](http://www.shop.iostens.com), or you may find a link to that site from [www.glenbardsouthhs.org](http://www.glenbardsouthhs.org)

Congratulations on your graduation from the eighth grade and your enrollment at Glenbard South High School! We know that the transition to high school is exciting, but we also realize that it is a big milestone that can bring new challenges. For that reason, Glenbard South has designed a student orientation called Raider Rush. Raider Rush provides students with the best opportunity for a successful beginning to their high school journey

**Raider Rush will take place on Friday, August 6<sup>th</sup>. It will begin at 10:00 am in the gym and will conclude at 2:00pm. All incoming students are encouraged to attend this orientation event!**

During Raider Rush, students will attend small-group orientation sessions led by student Link Leaders. Link Crew is a freshman mentorship program designed to welcome new students to Raider Nation, connect them with upperclassmen student mentors (Link Leaders), and equip new students with useful information to help them start off their high school journey with success. Our Link Leaders have undergone several hours of training so that they can assist new students with this transition.

Sessions held during Raider Rush will acquaint students with members of the staff, allow students the opportunity to meet other new students, provide an overview of the academic resources available at Glenbard South, address expectations for behavior, explain extracurricular opportunities, introduce students to the culture and traditions of Glenbard South, and provide recommendations for academic success and practical tips to help your student succeed at Glenbard South.

On August 6<sup>th</sup>, we will provide a bus route so all new students can attend. At Back to School Day on Monday, August 2nd, students will receive information about their bus routes and times. Busses will pick students up at their assigned stops, and will transport students back to their regular stops at the conclusion of Raider Rush.

Please encourage your student to eat breakfast before attending the orientation event. Students **do not** need to bring anything with them, including iPads, and students will be asked to put their cell phones away during Raider Rush. They should dress comfortably and be prepared to be active. # **Athletic Registration Information 2021-2022**

Registration for athletics is done through our online system

To tryout, a player must present a properly completed IHSA physical exam form (for freshman, a copy/original of the freshman physical form will be accepted), physicals are good for 13 months, have completed the on-line athletic registration through PowerSchool and the one time \$150.00 athletic fee prior to the first contest. **A player will not be allowed to tryout unless the above registration requirements are met. Instructions for how to register for athletics through PowerSchool are included in this packet. Fees can be paid on-line at the time of registration. Athletic fees may also be included in payment plans, if qualified, and declared at the beginning of the school year.**

**Note:** Verify demographics for all your students before trying to register for athletics.

- Register for athletics before signing up for a payment plan or athletics must be paid in full.
- If payment plan installments are not made by the set due dates, you will be removed from the payment plan and athletic fees will be due in full immediately.

1) In PowerSchool, click on **Athletics** from the menu on the left or click on a student's name in Step 2 of the Registration Wizard.

2) Read and agree to the agreements that appear on screen

3) To register a student for athletics select a **Season**, select a **Sport**, and click **Submit**.

**Note:** You can select sports from multiple seasons before clicking Submit.

4) You can continue to register additional students for sports, by clicking on their names in step 2 Registration Wizard.

5) After your student(s) have been registered, click **Student Fees** from the menu on the left side of the page or Click the **Click here to pay student fees** link from Step 3 of the Registration Wizard.

6) In the fee system, click the **Check Out** button in the upper-right to make payment.

7) Provide payment details and click the **Submit Payment** button.

# Online Registration Through Glenbard

**Establish Your Account:** Do you already have a **Glenbard** PowerSchool parent account?

- **YES** – Great, then the entire registration process can be completed with just a few clicks.
- **YES, but I have an incoming freshman** – Simply add a new student to your existing parent account by clicking on the **Add new students** through **Account Preferences** link.
- **NO** - If you have not created a parent account on PowerSchool you will need to establish one before proceeding. We have provided some basic instructions on the back of this flyer and more information at <https://ps.glenbard.org> to establish your account.

## **Register & Pay:**

1. If you received a letter in May to **verify residency** this must be completed before proceeding to PowerSchool. Reference the instructions in the May letter to verify residency. \*
2. **Log in** to PowerSchool on or after **Thursday July 1st, 2021**, and follow the on-screen instructions. There are help files and video tutorials there to assist you. **Both parent/guardian AND student(s) will be required to be present during online registration to individually agree to handbooks, agreements, and terms & conditions.**
3. **Review** your information and your student's information. **Submit changes** if needed.
4. **Register for a sport** if you wish to pay for it on a payment plan.
5. **Click on Student Fees** to complete the process and make your Registration Payment online. If you would like to pay for athletics on a payment plan, your student must be registered for at least one sport **before setting up a payment** plan for registration fees. You must register and pay by midnight **Thursday July 29th, 2021** to receive the discounted registration fee.

Desired Username	Enter a username you would like to use when logging into PowerSchool (not your email). The username must be unique from all others usernames in the district.
Password	Enter the password you would like to use when logging into the PowerSchool Parent Portal. The password must be a minimum of 6 characters.

4. **Link your student(s) to your PowerSchool account by entering their information Access ID and Access Password** found in a separate mailing the week of July 4th. When you are finish, select **Create Account**.
