Student drop off information:

Each school day, we have a traffic pattern in place between 7:00am-7:40am. The morning traffic pattern is "one-way". Please enter Glenbard South from Butterfield Rd. and exit using Park Blvd. Students should be dropped off in the designated area. Do not drop off students on Butterfield Rd. Once vehicles enter the drop off area, they will be held until students are clear. The next group of vehicles will pull forward and the process will repeat until all students/staff are safely dropped off to school.

The lane closest to the stadium should only be used to drive thru or park.

Bus Information

Bus route Information is updated each school year and can be found on our <u>Glenbard South website</u> under the Bus link. Some routes occasionally change. Please make sure to look at your route information prior to the start of the school year.

In addition, we have a Late Bus and an Athletic Bus available after school. The Late Bus leaves South at 4:00pm and the Athletic Bus at 5:30pm. Each bus covers the entire South boundaries but makes limited stops.

Registration Information and Assistance

All registration information can be found on our <u>Glenbard South website</u>. Some families may need assistance with the registration process. We have building hours allocated on Tuesday, July 26 from 8am-7pm and on Thursday, July 28 from 1pm-7pm. School counselors and administrators will be on hand to provide support. To schedule an appointment, please call us at (630)469-6500.

Health requirements for incoming 9th grade students

All Freshmen students must submit proof of having immunizations and a health examination. The Health Examination must be signed by a physician, nurse practitioner, or physician's assistant.

Without a completed health examination and proof of immunizations, your student will not be allowed to complete the registration process, receive their iPad or attend the first day of classes on August 10.

Health records from the middle schools and or an IHSA sports physical do not meet the school requirements.

Health requirements for incoming 12th grade students

The Illinois Department of Public Health requires all students entering or continuing in Grade 12 to show proof of receiving two doses of the meningococcal vaccine on or after the 11th birthday or one dose if the initial dose is given on or after the 16th birthday. The Glenbard South Health Office is requesting that all incoming seniors provide proof that they have received their immunizations prior to the first day of school. Students not in compliance on the first day of school will be excluded from school until proof of vaccine is received.

2022 Fall Sports Tryout and Athletic Registration Information

Registration for athletics is done through our online system. Instructions are below.

To tryout, a player must present a properly completed IHSA physical exam form (for freshman, a copy/original of the freshman physical form will be accepted), physicals are good for 13 months, have completed the online athletic registration through PowerSchool and the one time \$150.00 athletic fee prior to the first contest. A player will not be allowed to try out unless the above registration requirements are met. Instructions for how to register for athletics through PowerSchool are included in this packet. Fees can be paid online at the time of registration. Athletic fees may also be included in payment plans, if qualified, and declared at the beginning of the school year.

Note: Verify demographics for all your students before trying to register for athletics.

· Register for athletics before signing up for a payment plan or athletics must be paid in full.

 \cdot If payment plan installments are not made by the set due dates, you will be removed from the payment plan and athletic fees will be due in full immediately.

1) In PowerSchool, click on Athletics from the menu on the left or click on a student's name in Step 2 of the Registration Wizard.

2) Read and agree to the agreements that appear on screen

3) To register a student for athletics select a Season, select a Sport, and click Submit. Note: You can select sports from multiple seasons before clicking Submit.

4) You can continue to register additional students for sports, by clicking on their names in step 2 Registration Wizard.

5) After your student(s) have been registered, click Student Fees from the menu on the left side of the page or Click the Click here to pay student fees link from Step 3 of the Registration Wizard.

6) In the fee system, click the Check Out button in the upper-right to make payment.

7) Provide payment details and click the Submit Payment button.

Glenbard moving to letter grades, updated GPA system in 2022-23

For the 2022-23 school year, we are making two changes to how student grades are recorded. First, we will switch from number grades (1, 2, 3, 4, 5) to letter grades (A, B, C, D, F). Secondly, we will change from a 5.0 system to a 4.0 system for calculating grade-point averages (GPA). This aligns with what most colleges and universities use, making the college application process clearer and more consistent for our students.

These changes only affect current students; alumni transcripts will *not* be affected.


This switch goes into effect for the fall 2022 semester and **does not affect students' academic standing**. We will continue to recognize students based on GPA achievements each semester with various honor roll designations and for graduating seniors. Also, Honors, Advanced Placement (AP) and Dual Credit courses will still receive an extra point for passing grades, as we will continue weighted grades for these courses.

The 5.0 GPA system that we have used up until this point is uncommon. Most other high schools, colleges and universities use a 4.0 system. Of the top 20 colleges and universities that our students attend after high school, all 20 use a 4.0 grade system. Because the 4.0 grading system is so widely used, our students had to convert their 5.0 GPA to a 4.0 GPA when applying to college and scholarships. This was extremely confusing for students, families and colleges. Our school counselors were regularly contacted about this issue and tried to provide clarity about how our 5.0 grading system worked in a predominantly 4.0 grading system world.

The change to our new grading system was reviewed and approved by the Student Performance and Achievement committee, Policy Committee and Board of Education this winter. We are excited about how this change will streamline postsecondary planning for our students and their families. If you have any questions, please contact your Assistant Principal for Instruction.
