#### Safety Drills at Glenbard South:

The safety of Glenbard South students and staff is our top priority each day. Part of staying safe is being prepared for emergencies. As such, Glenbard South conducts all required drills in accordance with the Regional Office of Education, the Dupage County Sheriff's Office and the Lisle/Woodridge Fire Department.

One of the required drills is to conduct an annual Lockdown/Violent Intruder Drill. This year the Lockdown/Violent Intruder Drill will be on October 3. During this drill, all students will view a safety video which explains our procedures for a Lock and Teach, Lockdown, and On-site and Off-site Evacuations. Following the video, we will practice a Lockdown drill. Students and staff will move to an area of the classroom where they are not visible. Lights will be turned off and doors will be secured. Administrators will check each room for any visible students, noise, or open doors. Once the building has been checked, the all-clear will be announced and classes will return to normal. Students can ask questions once the drill is complete.

Please talk with your student about the importance of taking all drills seriously in order to help keep Glenbard South as safe as possible.

#### PSAT/NMSQT

All Juniors will be participating in the **PSAT/NMSQT exam on Wednesday, October 12th**. This will be a non-attendance day for the 9th, 10th, and 12th grade students. Juniors will be registered through the school and do not need to do or pay anything to take the exam. This is an important exam to prepare for the SAT in April.

#### **Parent Teacher Conference**

Parent-teacher conferences will be held on October 26 and 27. Both school days will be early release days for students (1:10 dismissal). On October 26, conferences will be virtual (on Zoom) from 4-8pm. On October 27, conferences will be in person, in classrooms, from 2-6pm. Friday, October 28 is a non-attendance day for all students.

Registration for Parent-teacher conferences will be done in Power PTC, which is accessed through PowerSchool. Families will be sent information about specific registration dates as soon as it is available.

#### The DuPage County Election Division

**The DuPage County Election Division** is excited to partner with high schools across DuPage County to get students engaged in the electoral process. More than 500 high school juniors and seniors have an opportunity to serve as a student judge in this election. That's two students per polling place!

The General Election will be held on Tuesday, November 8, 2022.

High school students who participate in the Student Election Judge Program play a crucial role in our democracy. #### **Senior Success**

School counselors have been busy meeting with seniors about their post high school plans. In addition, school counselors just wrapped up Senior Success Week. These important meetings took place during the first half of a senior's lunch period the week of Labor Day.

Seniors were asked to please complete three tasks in Naviance. Here are instructions for seniors to <u>log</u> <u>in to Naviance</u>. They must: 1. Add schools to "Colleges I'm Applying to" in Naviance; 2. Sign up for a College rep, Military rep or a Career speaker; and 3. Complete the Senior Profile Survey in Naviance. Seniors will find the Senior Profile on the Naviance Home Page under "Important To-Do's and Tasks." There are 4 quick questions required of all seniors. If your senior anticipates needing a college/scholarship counselor recommendation, they should complete all of the questions with detail to help their counselor write a strong recommendation letter.

School counselors continue to host the Senior Success Monday Series this semester. These meetings take place after school, during our PLC time on Mondays, from 1:55pm-2:35pm.
