SCHOOL DAY STUDY COMMITTEE UPDATE SET FOR NOV. 3

Dear D87 Families,

I am excited about Glenbard's study of a school day model that will meet a variety of needs in our school.

Our district's School Day Study Committee is in year two of studying our eight-period schedule in comparison with alternatives used in other school districts. While implementation of a new school day model would not begin until the 2023-24 school year at the earliest, we want to give you an update on the School Day Study Committee's work.

Glenbard District 87 will host a Zoom Webinar about the school day study at 7 p.m. Thursday, Nov. 3, at [this link](#). There will be an opportunity for viewers to submit questions and feedback, which will be used to help in the planning stages and developing future FAQ documents. A recording of the webinar also will be available on the district website after Nov. 3.

The School Day Study Committee is studying these key focus areas:

- Extended opportunities for deeper learning - Which schedule models allow for deeper learning experiences for students?
- Physiological supports - Which models are best suited to meet students' physical and mental health needs?



- Student supports and enrichment - We want time during the school day for all students to have opportunities for enrichment, getting ahead on their studies; and it's especially important for students who struggle to get the help they need during the school day.
- Staff Collaboration - Which models are best suited for educators to collaborate around instructional practices and designing learning experiences that are impactful?

I hope you will join the webinar at 7 p.m. Thursday, Nov. 3, at [this link](#) for an update on the School Day Study Committee's work and incredible opportunities for our students.

ENROLLMENT PROCESS BEGINS FOR THE 2023-2024 SCHOOL YEAR



We will begin our enrollment and course selection process for the 2023-24 school year soon. Starting as early as October 24th through mid-November, teachers will begin to talk to students about the course options in their area available for next school year. These decisions are informed by PSAT scores, current course performance and each student's post-secondary goals. Students will have a recommended course in PowerSchool in the areas of Math, Science, English and Social Studies. Our intention is to place students in the most challenging courses within these areas so that they are most prepared for the post high school experience. All families will have the opportunity to review these recommendations and work with the school counselor to finalize course selections through December 2022 and January 2023. Look for more detailed information from the school counseling office by the beginning of December.
