SPRING TESTING DAYS

- Wednesday, April 10, 2024: All Juniors at Glenbard South will take the School-day SAT with Essay. This exam will be administered digitally, on student iPads.
 - This is a non-attendance day for 9th, 10th, and 12th grade students.
 - Makeup Testing Date: Thursday April 25, 2024

- Thursday, April 11, 2024: All 9th and 10th grade students at Glenbard South will take the PSAT. This exam will be administered digitally, on student iPads.
 - This is a non-attendance day for 11th, and 12th grade students.
- Thursday, April 25, 2024: Makeup SAT and PSAT Testing Date
 - Students will be called out of classes if a makeup test is needed.
 - This is a regular attendance day for all other students.
- May 6–10 and May 13–17: AP Exams administered at Glenbard South.
 - Each exam is administered on a different day, based on a schedule set by the College Board. Students registered for the exam in the Fall through AP Classroom.



Counselors are helping our seniors identify in Schoolinks what college they want their final transcripts sent to. We are available to help students compare award letters and help families make their final college decisions. It is an exciting time

for our seniors! Seniors also have to complete the Senior Graduation Survey in Schoolinks.

Sometimes we ask our seniors to complete this survey while they wait to meet with their counselor. Our office staff is available to help them with this task.

College of DuPage

College of DuPage has been at Glenbard South on a several advisory dates to conduct application workshops and to go over next steps with our seniors who have already applied. If your senior plans to apply and follow up on next steps from home, please refer to this checklist to <u>apply to</u> <u>COD</u>.

FAFSA required for seniors!

 A non-academic graduation requirement is to either complete the FAFSA or if you do NOT intend to complete the FAFSA, you must complete the digital FAFSA Non-Participation Form. <u>Here is a PDF of the instruction sheet</u> for filling out that form.

Some tips for a successful FAFSA completion:

- 1. For those of you that have not created a FSA ID, please use <u>this linked document</u> to create it. It is advised that it is created at least 2 days prior to the filing the FAFSA. Both parents and students need their own FSA ID.
- 2. Both students and parents have a section of the online application to fill out.
- 3. Access to your 2022 tax forms, W-2s, and social security numbers for both you and your student.
- 4. Final list of colleges your senior is applying to.
