Important School Safety Update

School Safety is our top priority at Glenbard South. Our District has adopted updated protocol for emergency situations, in collaboration with the "I Love U Guys" Foundation. Students and staff at each Glenbard school will be training and practicing the new protocol. We wanted to share a summary of our five specific actions that can be performed during an incident that occurs at school. These actions are:

Hold, Secure, Lockdown, Evacuate, and Shelter.

Please watch our emergency actions video for a quick overview.

The following are brief descriptions of the five actions:

HOLD

Clear the hallways and remain in a room or area until the "All Clear" is announced. Staff close and lock doors, and classes proceed as normal.

Example: A Medical situation that requires emergency personnel to move quickly through the hallways.

SECURE

Quickly get inside the building, and all outside doors are locked. No visitors will be admitted. Classes proceed as normal.

Example: Police activity in the neighborhood.

LOCKDOWN

Proceed to a secure room, lock doors, turn off lights and move out of sight. Example: A report of an imminent threat in the building.

EVACUATE

Exit the building in an efficient and organized manner. Staff members lead the students to an evacuation location away from the hazard, and then account for students and adults present. Example: Fire in the building.

SHELTER

Varies based on the type of hazard. Students and staff move to a designated shelter area, either inside or outside the building.

Example: A tornado warning in the area.



Bus Information

Glenbard contracts with Safeway for bus transportation services. Students who are eligible for bus transportation can find their bus route information on their schedules that were distributed at Back-to-School Week. Additional transportation information can be found on our <u>website</u>.

In addition, Glenbard South High School has implemented Here Comes the Bus, a bus tracking and communication app for your smartphone or desktop. Here Comes the Bus will allow our students and families the ability to know where their bus is before school and after school. You may register at any time. Additional information can be found <u>HERE</u>.

Student drop off information

Each school day, we have a traffic pattern in place between 7:15 AM - 8:00 AM. The morning traffic pattern is "one-way". Please enter Glenbard South from Butterfield Rd. and exit using Park Blvd. Students should be dropped off in the designated area. Do not drop off students on Butterfield Rd. Once vehicles enter the drop off area, they will be held until students are clear. The next group of vehicles will pull forward and the process will repeat until all students/staff are safely dropped off to school. Maintaining the safety of our students as they are dropped off, is a priority. Please be patient and arrive early to avoid traffic. DuPage County Sheriff will be on site to assist with a smooth morning drop off.

The lane closest to the stadium should only be used to drive thru or park.





The lane closest to the school is reserved for bus drop off only. The 2 middle lanes are for student drop off. Staff will be on site to provide safe crossing for students. Cars cannot move until students are clear from the area.

The lane closest to the stadium is for driving thru and parking in the student/staff parking ot. For safety reasons, students should not be dropped off in this lane of traffic.

Students can enter the building at Door #1 (Bus/Student Drop off area) or Door #4 (Main Entrance). Students must show their school ID when entering the building.
